Your adventure starts here

If you are looking for an active holiday, Västervik is the right destination for you - all year round. The environments in and around Västervik – both on land and in the water – are high class and of great variety. Sport fishing attracts athletes from all over Europe, and the climbing offers one of the world's best bouldering areas. The kayaking is popular because of the short distance between the city and the outer archipelago. Hiking trails stretch from the inland to the coast, and out on the islands of the archipelago.

FIVE ADVENTURES ON LAND

Tiustleden

Västervik's flagship hiking trail is called Tjustleden, which stretches through the entire municipality of Västervik. It is 200 km divided into nine stages, with varied and beautiful natural experiences through forested and cultural countryside.

Mountain biking at Karstorp

The Karstorp recreation area on the southern outskirts of Västervik has, in recent years, been transformed into mountain bikers' favorite place. The terrain consists of forest, rocky outcrops and slopes and includes two classic loops and three XCO courses.

Climb on classic ground

Over the past decade, Västervik has established itself as one of Europe's best bouldering climbing areas, with classic routes such as the Hourglass at Björnblocket and Fruberget at Segersgärde. There is also sport climbing with ropes, offering different levels of difficulty and character.

Around Gränsö

One of the most popular hiking trails in Västervik municipality is Gränsöleden. It's easy to see why. Close to the city and adjacent to the sea, it is easy to divide into trails that suit both families with small children and experienced hikers. Start at Gränsö Castle and embark on the just over one km long hike.

Training + cycling = true

Start your cycling adventure with a cool train ride. From Västervik, the museum railway, Smalspåret, departs daily during the summer. You can bring your bicycle on board and then cycle the route Ankarsrum – Västervik. The course is about 60 km long and consists of mixed terrain, varying between small roads, gravel roads and forest paths.





FIVE ADVENTURES ON WATER

Kayaking

There are plenty of kayak rental companies in Västervik municipality, and whether you choose to start from Västervik's city center or any other location, you are never too far from the outer archipelago. Pack your tent and experience the adventure and freedom of staying overnight on any of the 5,000 islands awaiting you.

Fishing

With all of its islets and skerries, Västervik is one of Sweden's best fishing spots, and it attracts anglers from all over Europe. Here you will find not only world-class pike fishing, but also good sea trout and perch fishing. It's versatility is distinctive. In addition to archipelago fishing, you can also fish for game fish in our lakes. In addition to the archipelago fishing, you can also fish in several lakes around the municipality – but a fishing license is required.

Canoeing on inland lakes

Canoeing on our lakes is a wonderful family activity. One of the canoe trails stretches all the way from Hummelstad in the middle of the municipality to Skaftet in the southern archipelago and takes you through a chain of lakes, rivers and canals. The total distance is almost 40 km, and you can choose whether you want to paddle a short stage for a few hours, or tackle the entire distance with overnight stays along the way.

Wreck diving

The unique diving waters around Västervik are among Sweden's least exploited. Through the Dive Park Västervik project, diving in the Västervik archipelago is easily accessible and safe for everyone, offering excellent dive sites and buoys for precise docking and safe descents and ascents.

Swimru

The combination of running and swimming is called swimrun, and several places in Västervik are perfect for both beginners and more experienced swimrunners. Start a course of laps and swim and run the same distance to keep track of your highs and lows. Please remember never to swim in the shipping channels.


FISHING

ARCHIPELAGO TRAFFIC

M/S Ellen Key and M/S Kung Märta provide regular services from Västervik - Idö and Västervik – Hasselö, and the boat trip takes about one hour. Both ferries depart 45 times per day during the peak

During the peak season (18/6-14/8) there are daily ferries from Loftahammar. Take the boat from Sandbyhovsbryggan in Loftahammar out to Rågö, before travelling on to Hasselö.

The trips can be booked online at boka.vastervik.com before departure, or purchased at the terminal.

For those who want a real archipelago experience, the best thing to do is to head for the little island of Idö in the outer archipelago. During the summer, several boats travel here each day from Horns Udde and from Västervik. Idö Skärgårdskrog is located in the island's harbour area, situated on a hill overlooking the sea.

THE PILOT LOOKOUT TOWER

From the small harbour it is only a few minutes' walk up to the island's white landmark - the old pilot lookout tower. Curious visitors who can

manage the narrow steps up to the top of the tower will be rewarded with a fabulous view of land and sea. On one side you have the mainland and on the other, the high seas. The old pilot lookout tower has been left untouched since it was closed in 1986, but you will still be able to gain an inkling of what it was like for the islanders in former times (a harsh way of life at times). From the top of the tower you will be able to catch a glimpse of a collection of red houses, and those who continue their archipelago expedition along a meandering forest path will eventually reach the village with its boathouses and ruminating cows. The real Saltkråkan.

BATHING AREAS

If you feel like a dip in one of Idö's many bays there is a good chance you will find a smooth rock where you will be completely alone. For those who don't want to or can't bathe from the rocks, there is also a shallow sandy beach. But bathing is far from the only water activity on offer to those who visit this little archipelago island. Eagle and seal safaris are other popular options.

Hasselö

During the summer you get there from Västervik on board the M/S Ellen Key. A brisk one hour boat ride, against a backdrop of blue waves, green islets, white sails and countless numbers of blue and yellow flags.

At the end of the journey you will see a wooded idyll with a sandy beach and red cottages. In the small harbour, a tractor awaits you to take you on a memorable sightseeing tour around the island. (Please note that this must be booked in advance - one day before.) If you prefer to rent your own bike, make your way to Handelsboa to pick up your "wheels".

HANDELSBOA

Bicycle-friendly dirt tracks span the length and breadth of the entire island. The Handelsboa harbour area serves as a lively central point for the whole island. A popular country store will supply you with everything you need for a successful stay in the archipelago. The store also rents out bikes, kayaks, canoes, pedal boats and golf clubs for games of minigolf. Just next door is a cafeteria where you can enjoy all of the day's meals if you want to. For those who prefer warmer water than the sea, there is also

YOUTH HOSTEL

The Falunred youth hostel, with its white trim around the windows, is the island's former primary school, and you can see pictures and class photos on the walls and an old climbing frame in the playground. There are thirty beds in the five bright and modern rooms of the main building and in a small, homely cottage. The hostel has a large garden, perfect for light summer nights where you can enjoy a barbecue, gameplay and relaxation. Opposite the youth hostel is the unmanned flea market which is open 24/07.

PLACES TO EAT ON HASSELÖ Restaurant Sjökanten

In the archipelago environment, lunch buffets and evening meals are served with fish from the farm's own fishermen and archipelago and mainland. Please note that your table by calling: (+46) 070-2349688.

Hagaslätt Home Bakery & Café

The café serves nourishing sandwiches, freshly baked buns, coffee, large waffles and whatever inspires us on the day.

Kaffeboa

This Café is open during the summer on Hasselö, located right by the visitor marina. The café offers both lunch and coffee.



BOAT TAXI

If you don't have your own boat, it is, in addition to the regular ferries, always possible to get around the archipelago with the help of a water taxi or by renting a motorboat or kayak. There are a number of companies that will rent you a boat/kayak.

TRAVEL BY MAIL BOAT

The boat that delivers the mail to the islanders in the central archipelago, to islands such as Norra Malmö, Smågö, Björkö and Hasselö, departs from Gränsö canal. The boat departs mondays, wednesdays and fridays. Reservations must be booked with Solidö archipelago taxi at least one day in advance. You can book your trip by calling (+46) 0490-91019.

THE ARCHIPELAGO WITHOUT A BOAT

You don't need a boat to enjoy the archipelago.

There are bridges to the archipelago islands such as **Stora** Askö and Östra Skälö. And the coastal communities of Loftahammar and Blankaholm provide a wonderful archipelago feeling without you having to leave the mainland. At **Händelöp**, just outside Västervik, you can experience a real island community without your own boat. The small and very vibrant fishing village was connected by bridge to the mainland in the 1960's, has increased while the houses and stores have been kept intact. The village of Händelöp arranges an inviting archipelago market on the Saturday of week 28.

RENT YOUR OWN BOAT

When you are in the city center, you have the option of accessing the archipelago by renting your own boat. The company Våg offers boats that are booked through their website, takeawave.se.

Loftahammar

Sun-drenched rocks from which to bathe, tarmacked jetties, screeching seagulls and ice cream. Loftahammar is a true summer holiday destination, an idyllic coastal town in the northern part of the municipality, which attracts holidaymakers from far and wide. This is where sailors, campers, motorcycle enthusiasts and summer cottage owners come to relax and unwind. In the winter, Loftahammar is a sleepy little island village. But when the sun comes out in the spring, there is an increase in the activity level in the town. Boats are launched into the lake and the people of Östergötland arrive and open their summer cottages. The dedicated seasonal campers take up their pitches on the camp sites and the sunbathers find their way out onto the rocks and beaches once again.

At the centre of Loftahammar, business activity increases and, at its centre, stands the little Ica supermarket.

Stures bakery (café and restaurant) on the main street is where the third generation of Anderssons provides Loftahammar with coffee, cakes, refreshments and food – another pleasant place you can't miss in Loftahammar.

For those who prefer an active holiday, a visit to **Sweeds** is a must. Here you can rent bikes and boats and arrange guided canoeing trips, walks and fishing tours. The best way to end a day in Loftahammar is with a walk through the visitor marina, strolling among the large and small boats, and then supper at **Sjökrogen**.



Rågö

The nature reserve Rågö is a popular gem with its fabulous archipelago nature, its own boat workshop, cackling island [birds] and mooing cows. You can really slow down and enjoy your holiday – stroll along untouched hiking trails, enjoy the sea views and swim from both beaches and cliffs.

Rågö restaurant, with the wonderful Anita Hultberg managing the kitchen, serves archipelago-inspired hot and cold dishes, as well as coffee with

homemade cakes. The restaurant also offers, among other things, archipelago dishes based on locally-fished specialties. There is the option to stay overnight in three nice rental houses, with a total of 24 beds. Rågö has also become a favorite destination for weddings and other major celebrations. The large barn can accomodate 50 people seated at tables. You can get there on the M/S Bella, which runs daily from Loftahammar in the summer. You can also take the boat from Västervik and change boats on Hasselö. Rågö has a vistor marina with almost 35 berths, in Alviken, south of the village.

Gamleby has both a hotel and bed & breakfast, as well as a well-stocked lca store, with its admired charcuterie department, where residents can buy everything they need for your stay. For those who wish to wet their whistle, there is also a liquor store.

The Swedish Floorball Open, or SFO, attracts the Swedish floorball elite and youth teams of all ages and from all parts of Sweden to Västervik. The audience is invited to a fast-paced, wonderful floorball party, with world-class floorball in a unique arena with Skeppsbrofjärden as the backdrop behind the floorball courts.

DRAKBÅTSFESTIVALEN, 8 JULY

Last year's Drakbåtsfestival was the first in 15 years and was a great success. Drakbåtsfestivalen will therefore return to Västervik in 2023. This will be a great festival when the teams compete in the race along Skeppsbrokajen.

HAMNPLAN LIVE, 8 JULY

With Skeppsbrofjärden as a backdrop, Hamnplan is transformed from a floorball party and Drakbåtsfetsivalen to a joint grand finale when Hamnplan Live takes over. No lesser lights than Hoffmaestro, Bolaget and 2 Blyga Läppar will be on stage.

VÄSTERVIK CITY RUN, 10 JULY

Västervik's big running party has runners traversing the city on a beautiful six kilometer long course, starting and finishing at Fiskaretorget.

VISFESTIVALEN, 13-15 JULY

Visfestivalen in Västervik has been held since 1966. Some of Sweden's best music artists will play in the beautiful and atmospheric castle ruins, a must for anyone who likes music. This year will see Anna Ternheim, Jill Johnson and the festival's all-star band Fest Totale on stage.

HASSELÖRODDEN, 19 JULY

The archipelago festival that takes you back to the old Västervik. Take a seat at Fiskaretorget and follow the boats as they make their way from Hasselö to Västervik, where the rowers WILL arrive in their oak boats around lunchtime.

DIGGILOO, 21 JULY

Get ready for a riproaring anniversary party in 2023 where everything is pumped to the max and there will be plenty of surprises on stage. Diggiloo will take over Västervik with a burst of hits, humor and a rare infectious joy of gaming, spread over three entertaining hours.

LOFTAHAMMAR ENDURANCE DAY, 22 JULY

The toughest challenge of the summer is the swimrun race, the Loftahammar Endurance Day, or LED as it is also called. Swim and run from Loftahammar all the way to Hasselö and back.

CHRIS KLÄFFORD & HIGHWAY HONEYS, 28 JULY

Båtsman Music presents Chris Kläfford & Highway Honeys. The fantastically picturesque cultural heritage area Båtsmansstugorna will arrange a concert evening filled with beautiful voices, sounds and awesome songs. On this evening, Highway Honeys and Chris Kläfford will provide the music.

LÖGA BEACH PARTY, 29 JULY

The biggest beach party of the summer is at Lögarbergen, just outside Västervik city center. Listen to concerts and dance the night away while the sun sets in Gamlebyviken. This year's lineup consists of Poaching, Medina and Markoolio.

VÄSTERVIK TRIATHLON, 12 AUGUST

A triathlon competition in central Västervik to which everyone, regardless of training level, is welcome. The competition is decided on two distances – 1500 meters swimming, 40 kilometers running and 10 kilometers running (Olympic). There is also a shorter variant.

SPORTS CAR DAY, 2-3 SEPTEMBER

The ultimate day for all motorsport fans. Arranged at Skeppsbrokajen with a packed schedule containing city races, exhibitions, entertainment and much more fun for all motor lovers.

MILITARY HISTORY MEETING, 2 SEPTEMBER

A meeting showcasing military historical vehicles, artillery, uniforms and other equipment, from several eras and countries.

ÖVERUM IRONWORKS MUSEUM

Cannons, horseshoes, nails and axes ... The traditional industrial town of Överum has a 360-year history of iron making. Today there is a small ironworks museum in the old hammer forge.



LUNDS BY

Visit Lunds By near Gladhammar and refuel your summer senses with Swedish country life and unbridled carpentry joy. This village dates back to the 1700's, and parts of the Children of Noisy Village were filmed here. There are three excellent hiking trails that start from the village.



VIRUM MOOSE PARK

A Wild Safari in Virum Moose Park will give you the opportunity to pet and feed the four-legged giants while you sit well protected in a carriage with a roof and open sides. Get your camera ready for some close encounters with the King of the forest. Round off your adventure in Småland with a cup of coffee and moose shopping at Älglogen.



ALMVIK'S BRICK-WORK MUSEUM

A well preserved industrial heritage that will give your imagination a spin, a testimony to hundreds of years of strenuous hard work. After the visit, you can relax and ponder what you have just witnessed at Almvik's café.



VÄSTERVIK RESORT

The resort's adventure pool has pools for all members of the family, including water slides, a wave pool and hot springs.



NATURUM VÄSTERVIK

A large exhibition about the sea and archipelago life. Go on a guided nature walk, learn more about bees and pollination, discover the exhibits and take a peek into the aquariums. Kulbacken also has Uno's tower, which offers magnificent views.



THE NARROW-GAUGE RAILWAY

Since the 1950's, the orange railcars have rumbled their way through the forests of Småland, between Hultsfred and Västervik. Between the mid-June and the beginning of September you can step onboard and experience a train journey from yesteryear. Departures times can be found at smalsparet.se.



GOLF & PADEL

One of Västervik's three golf courses is in Loftahammar. The popular 9-hole course offers a driving range and a practice area. The club also has a padel tennis court.



GRÄNSÖ CASTLE'S CANDLE-MAKER

Lovingly handmade creations made of stearin are manufactured and sold in a historical building in the cultural area of Kulbacken. Even the King of Sweden has purchased candles from Gränsö Castle's candle-maker.



TINDERED COUNTRY KITCHEN

Tindered Country Kitchen along the E22 motorway north of Västervik has been named Road House of the Year on several occasions. The ingredients come from the owner's own farm and others in the area, and many of the dishes and pastries are made from the family's recipe book passed down through the generations. A wonderful setting next to Lake Ommen.



ODDIS PLAYLAND

Play in the playland, challenge your friends to LaserGame, eat good food, snacks, coffee or play fun games. There are many fun activities for the whole family, and the café serves coffee, drinks, sandwiches, salad and sweets.



TALES AND LEGENDS

The top of Garpedansberget features a sculpture park with an interesting collection of gnomes, goblins and elves. On KustCamp Gamleby, you can book a hike on the fairy-tale trail with troll mother Grimhild.



ASTRID LINDGREN'S WORLD

In Vimmerby's fairytale theme park, you can meet Astrid Lindgren's characters in their authentic environments and see how the familiar stories come to life. The nearby cultural area, Astrid Lindgren's Näs, also awaits you. You can visit the extensive exhibitions, take a peek at the author's childhood home, experience the lush theme gardens and enjoy the flavours that Småland has to offer.



JAILBREAK

The company, Jailbreak Västervik, has opened an Escape Room at Welux's premises in Västervik. Escape Room is a game idea where a group is locked in a room. To get out, you have to solve quests, codes, puzzles and other challenges within 60 minutes.



EDSBRUK ART & CAFÉ

Enjoy a crispy waffle next to a gushing waterfall and take the opportunity to explore our various art exhibitions in a lovely mill environment from the 1600s.



ALVIKENS DISC GOLF COURSE

This is an 18 hole course that was completed in 2019. The course has already hosted the Swedish Championships three times (2019-2021).



BÅTMANSSTUGORNA

Båtsmansgränd is lined by small boatswains' log cabins, once used as homes for the boatswains who worked for Tjust Båtsmanskompani. Today, it houses a café, hostel and a herb garden.



GRÄNSÖ CASTLE

Gränsö castle, the region's only four-star superior facility, has expanded its spa facilities. A brand new spa and relaxation area with four new indoor water attractions and a new large infinity pool right on the seafront have been added to provide guests with more experiences and greater relaxation. A new beautiful outdoor area has also been added as well as new fittings. Gränsö castle is located in the middle of the nature reserve, just a few minutes drive from the centre of Västervik. The facilities are open to the public and there are places to bathe at Ekholmen which is situated close by, along with parks and beautiful areas for walking and picnicking. The café is open daily during the summer.



LOFTA CAFFÈ

Coffee and culture can be enjoyed in the excellent Lofta Caffè operated by Frank and Cécile in Lofta's old elementary school. Freshly ground espresso, tasty pastries, friendly conversations and an art exhibition provide for a more relaxing day. Around the corner, there are petroglyphs on display, and if you would really like to do more, you should make your way over to Loftaleden along a 20 km long walk in green surroundings.



LOFTA

The cosy Lofta Caffè offers ever-changing art exhibitions in combination with Italian coffee culture. Just around the corner there are petroglyhs you can take a look at. If you get a taste for nature you should walk along the Loftaleden – a 20 km long hiking trail in scenic surroundings.



ASPAGÅRDEN

In one of the oldest buildings in Västervik, A ceramicist and a textile artist work here. Take a look and discover the magic of craftsmanship.



SMULTRONBODA SHEEP FARM

The Smultronboda sheep farm practises sheep husbandry. There is also a smoke house, farm shop with local food and crafts. The farm also offers holiday lets and short term accommodation. Enjoy coffee in the garden, pet the lambs in the pasture and buy some award winning cured meats and provisions.



WIMMERSTRÖMSKA

Visit an authentic manor house and see how the fascinating Stina Wimmerström lived. Västervik's Art Group is housed in the main building, don't miss their exhibits.



SEGERSGÄRDE NATURE RESERVE

The nature reserve Segersgärde is a classic area to visit. Elder-flowers and early purple orchids and more grow on the flowery slopes. If you walk the path up to the top of Örnberget or Fruberget you will be rewarded by a heavenly view of the archipelago. With a little luck, you may see white-tailed eagles soaring on high. Along the trail there is a fantastic cave that will impress both children and adults. Fruberget is also a renowned climbing area, so you may meet a few climbers with crash pads on their backs making their way up to the mountain's many boulders.
